

## Specific Transition Activities

1. Meet with the new teacher about the children who will transition into new setting in the fall. Meet with Head Start teacher when transitioning from Early Head Start to Head Start.
2. Remind parent of any specific upcoming activities (Kindergarten round-up) in your district, review with Head Start the expectations of their local Kindergarten.
3. Ask the new teacher to come in and visit your class.
4. Visit the new classroom during the program year.
5. Keep in contact with the new teacher about the children who will be transitioned.
6. Ask your school for a list of the things the children will need to bring to new setting and give them to parents.
7. Remind parents about how important it is that they keep in contact with their child's teacher as they move through the school years.
8. Give each child who is going to transition to Kindergarten a backpack and appropriate supplies.
9. Follow-up in the fall by meeting with the new teacher. Discuss what went smoothly and what else could be done to make this process more successful.
