PURPOSE AND PRIORITY

The purpose of our weatherization program is to increase the energy efficiency of dwellings owned or occupied by low-income persons, reduce their total residential expenditures, and improve their health and safety, especially low-income persons who are particularly vulnerable such as the elderly, persons with disabilities, families with children, high residential energy users, and households with high energy burdens.

Each year, a limited number of households who income-qualify for energy assistance are able to have their homes weatherized. In addition to income-qualification, we follow our state weatherization policy manual and give priority to those households that are listed in our purpose statement in the preceding paragraph. Applications with higher priority will be inserted into a waiting list ahead of the applicants with lower priority criteria.

ELIGIBILITY

If your dwelling has been weatherized previously by NWCA, you may not be eligible. Exceptions are homes that we partially weatherized prior to ten years ago, or homes that have been damaged by flood, fire, or act of God and not paid for by insurance or other federal funds.

If you own and occupy your home, you may be eligible for repair work to your furnace or water heater. In addition, if you reside in areas served by Otter Tail Power or MERC, you may be eligible for one of their conservation improvement programs.
